
Fathers and Sons Logic

Through the ages and around the world sons have called their fathers by many different names. Carter, David, Felix, and Will each use a different name for their father. Based on the clues decide which name each person uses: Dad, Daddy, Father, or Papa.

- 1. None of the boys calls his parent a name that starts with the same letter as his own name.
- 2. Carter said, "I wouldn't want to use 'Father' or 'Papa'."
- 3. All the boys use a parent name that has the same number of syllables as their own name.



Use the grid, if you would like, to eliminate possibilities. Put an "x" in a box if you know a father's name doesn't go with a boy. Put an "o" if you know it does.

Solution to Fathers and Sons Logic

Carter uses 'Daddy'.

David uses 'Father'.

Felix uses 'Papa'.

Will uses 'Dad'.
